

From 1 July 2013, according to Regulation (EU) No 305/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 March 2011, laying down harmonized conditions for the marketing of construction products and repealing Council Directive 89/106/EEC, European Technical Assessments (ETA) may be issued for construction products for which no relevant harmonized standards exist.

An ETA is a reference document enabling the manufacturer to draw up the declaration of performance and to place CE marking on construction products.

The Road and Bridge Research Institute is authorized to issue ETAs for the following areas of construction products:
